
LEAVE WILD BABY HARES ALONE!

 Our local Jackrabbit is actually a White-tailed Prairie Hare. They live in the city and other urban areas. They like open spaces (parks, school yards)

• Baby hares are different than baby rabbits. They are born with all their fur and their eyes open. They can hop around soon after birth.

- Baby hares are born Mar-Sept
- Female hares leave their babies alone during the day so she does not attract predators to them.
 This is normal. She returns to feed them during the night.



• Baby hares stay very still. This is normal behavior. Do not pick them up! Help our wildlife stay wild! Remember:

If You See a Baby Hare, Leave it Right There!
